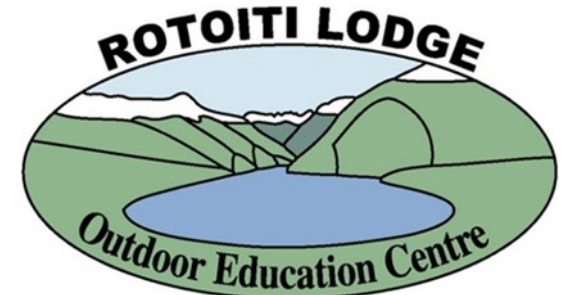

About the Lodge

Rotoiti Lodge is situated within Nelson Lakes National Park and is within easy walking distance to the small township of Saint Arnaud. It has been built atop a small rise to give it stunning views of the surrounding mountains.

The Lodge was built in 1967 as an Outdoor Education Centre for various schools around the Nelson and Marlborough area to have their camps. Outside of the school terms and in weekends the Lodge is opened for use for various activities, such as community groups, work seminars, birthdays and even weddings.



Activities in the Area

- Walking - Being situated within the National Park, there are many beautiful walks right off the front doorstep.
- Hunting and Fishing
- Mountain biking - Teetotal has a wide range of tracks for all abilities.
- Watersports - Lake Rotoiti is a stunning backdrop for canoeing, waterskiing, and sailing.
- Four-wheel driving
- Skiing/Snowboarding - Rainbow Ski Field is only 40 minutes drive away.

Facilities

Hall – Carpeted area with large fireplace and comfortable seating, 75" TV. Vinyl dining area with chairs and tables for 120 people.

Deck—250m2 deck area that flows out from the main hall with large tables and seating

Kitchen – Fully stocked kitchen capable of catering for 120 people

Dorm rooms – 74 beds in 11 rooms* with mattresses

Bathrooms – 2 large bathrooms with 4 toilets and 4 showers each (plus the three on suite bathrooms)

Basic amenity gear – toilet paper, tea towels, brooms, mops, cleaning sprays, rubbish bags all provided

Heating – Large fireplace in the main hall, plus a large diesel heater for the rest of the building
